- The maritime industry provides the most costeffective, energy-efficient, and dependable mode of transportation for long distances.
- A considerable and increasing proportion of this volume, accounting for about 35 percent of total volumes and over 60 percent of commercial value, is carried in containers.
- Container ports are critical nodes in global supply chains and essential to the growth strategies of emerging economies.
- Efficient, high quality port infrastructure can facilitate investment in production and distribution systems, engender expansion of manufacturing and logistics, create employment opportunities, and raise income levels.
- Report utilizes data from a total of 348 ports over the full calendar year of 2022.
- ***Of the top 10 ranked ports, 9 have either maintained or improved their position since CPPI 2021.
